### **Contest Rules**

- Any art medium may be used, such as computer art, markers, pencils, crayons, paint, or photography.
- Artwork submissions must be photographed or scanned and then emailed. Please see the right sidebar for instructions.
- If a person's face is used in the photo, the artist must have the individual's permission.
- High resolution digital images (150 dpi or higher) sized between 5.5"x8.5" and 11"x17", and in landscape orientation are preferred.
- Artwork that does not adhere to the rules may be disqualified.
- All submissions become property of the City of Fairview Park.
