MEDICAL, RELIGIOUS, OR PHILOSOPHICAL
EXEMPTION FORM
Ohio Revised Code, Sections 3313.67 and 3313.671

Pursuant to O.R.C. Sec. 3313.671(B)(1)-(3), a pupil who has had natural rubella, mumps, or chicken pox, and presents a signed statement from the pupil's parent, guardian, or physician to that effect, is not required to be immunized against such infection.

Pursuant to O.R.C. Sec. 3313.671(B)(4), a pupil who presents a written statement of the pupil's parent or guardian in which the parent or guardian objects to the immunization for good cause, including religious convictions, is not required to be immunized.

Pursuant to O.R.C. Sec. 3313.671(B)(5), a child whose physician certifies in writing that such immunization against any disease is medically contraindicated is not required to be immunized against that disease.

Except as provided in O.R.C. Sec. 3313.67(A)(2), the Board of Education may make and enforce rules to secure the immunization of, and to prevent the spread of communicable diseases among the pupils attending or eligible to attend the schools of the District, as, in its opinion, the safety and interest of the public require.
