Grading Breakdown

Projects = 80% of total grade

- Checkpoints are required to be completed in order to submit Final Products
- Final Products are graded through the Cognitive Skill Rubric

Power Focus Areas= 14% of total grade

- These need to be completed by the end of the school year
- Focus areas that are not completed by the suggested time will be marked in **RED** and will negatively affect your grade

Additional Focus Areas= 6% of total grade

• These are required to be completed in order to earn the highest grade possible

Deadline Policy

- Projects must to be submitted ON THE PLATFORM DUE DATE
- There is a one-week grace-period past the deadline. If there is a possibility your project might be submitted late for any reason, you must conference with me in person or through email and/or attend OFFICE HOURS Tuesday and Wednesday after school
- In order to submit the Final Products, all required checkpoints in the project need to be completed and marked **GREEN** or **YELLOW**
- You must use class time wisely in order to follow the correct pace to meet the deadline of the project

## Focus Area Requirements

- All Power Focus Areas need to be completed by the end of the school year
- You must follow the pacing in the platform and in class in order to complete all focus areas in a timely manner
- Use the Goal-Setting tool to help you stay on pace
- Focus areas that are not completed on time will be marked in **RED** and will negatively affect your grade
- Focus areas are to be taken in class during SDL time
- You may only request a focus area once you have completed **at least 1 page** of notes in your notebook using the resources in the focus area
- You need to complete an Assessment Template while taking the focus area that is checked by me BEFORE submitting the assessment
- You may retake a focus area once you have shown you have prepared by taking more notes and reviewing focus area materials
- You make retake a focus area once on the same day only if you have received a 7/10



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
