Harassment/Intimidation/Bullying Report Confirmed Incidents: First Semester, 2023-2024

As required by Ohio Revised Code ORC 3313.666 and Board of Education Policy 10.05, the school district administration should semiannually provide the president of the district board a written summary of all reported incidents and post the summary on its website, if the district has a website, to the extent permitted by section 3319.321 of the Revised Code and the "Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974," 88 Stat. 571, 20 U.S.C. 1232g, as amended.

In accordance with Policy 10.05, harassment, intimidation, or bullying means any intentional written, electronic, verbal, or physical act that a student has exhibited toward another particular student more than once and the behavior both:

- A. Causes mental or physical harm to the other students; and
- B. Is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other student.
