Dear Parent or Guardian,

We are so excited to be returning to our regular school schedule. We will transition from the hybrid half day model to having all day kindergarten on Monday March 1. The new schedule will look a little different due to transportation schedules around the district. Please note the arrival and dismissal times and the carline drop off and pick up times. Kindergarten students cannot enter the building until 8:30.

Once we return to "ALL IN" the morning car line will have a bit more traffic. Please be patient. A staff member will come to your car and assist in getting your child. If your child is in a car seat please have them unbuckled and ready when it is your turn. We are doing the best we can to make sure this is all done in a timely manner and your cooperation with adhering to the time slots for each program will help.

If your child is riding the bus, please understand that we share transportation with Gilles Sweet. We are adding more children to the buses and this may delay pick up and drop off times. The postcards you received are approximate times so please be early to the bus stop in the morning. The postcards had one error ALL IN will begin on **Monday March 1**. All safety protocols in the building will remain in place. Parents are still not permitted in the building except for emergencies. If you need to drop off or pick up your child outside the carline times please come to the front entrance and ring the bell. Students ages 3 and older are required to wear a mask. Please make sure your child has at least one extra mask each day in case one gets dirty. Kindergarten students will eat lunch in the gym. The students will sit in small groups of 4 at a table with plastic dividers. They will be required to sit in the same place each day. Lunch will be 30 minutes and recess will be 30 minutes.

Kindergarteners will go outside for recess weather permitting (20 degrees or above). Please dress your child accordingly. The children will be required to wear their masks for recess. We will continue to try and minimize the number of children in the halls and restrooms. Sanitizing and handwashing will continue to be a priority.

Students returning to school are expected to be here everyday. If your child is sick or will be out for another reason please call the office to report the absence at 440-356-3515 ext 1200. The absence policy will be followed starting March 1, 2021.

Students in the **Remote Learning Option** will continue with their regular schedule. If you have questions regarding the remote learning option please contact Trish Moran at pmoran@fairview.k12.oh.us or call at 440-356-3515 ext 1129. You must contact the office if you are planning to make a change from remote learning.

We will start having breakfast for kindergarten on March 1. Students will be able to receive a Grab and Go breakfast to take to their room. If you would like to participate in the breakfast program please let your child's teacher know. The hot lunch program will also start on March 1. You can find the lunch menu [here](#) in the upper right hand corner of the page. All students can receive a free lunch for the 2020-21 school year. Students will be required to order lunch in the morning. Teachers report lunch counts by 9:15 am.

We will continue to take temperatures when students arrive. If your child is sick please keep them home. Students must be fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication before they can return.

We have slowly been increasing the number of children in the building since June 15. With your cooperation and patience things have continued to improve. We are all so excited to be inching towards a more normal looking school day and schedule. We appreciate your continued support as we take another step towards normalcy.
